Law and Society

- The view of certain jurists (like H. Kelsen) that the jurist should not discuss the question of social interests, this view not only is attractive in as much as it encourages an impartial legal doctrine, but also is essential to the lawyer to enable him to properly understand the legal system.
- This view is based on a fundamental principle which governs the nature of the relation between "law" and "society".

Law and Society

But most of the jurists of the twentieth century look at the legal doctrine as a branch of social sciences (sociology), and look at the legal theory as a sociology of law. The sociology of law is thus a branch of sociology dealing with law and legal institutions in the light of sociological principles, aims and methods.

Law and Society

The last view is that relationship between law and social interests may usefully be studied by jurists. This view is based on two reasons.
